

Forward Fax to email

Forward incoming faxes to your email

Do you need to forward the faxes you receive via the Microsoft's Fax Console (Fax Console is the fax ability of Windows XP Professional, Windows Server, Windows Vista Business/Ultimate and all versions of Windows 7) to one or more email address anywhere in the world?

Now with the Successful Software's ForwardFax2Email (forward fax to email) solution you can automate the whole thing in less than 5 minutes.

How it works

-

You simply install the Successful Software's ForwardFax2Email solution to the machine that receives the faxes. This is usually a Windows computer that has the Fax Console of Windows (in Windows Vista and Windows 7 this place is called "Windows Fax and Scan") installed on it. If you do not know how to do this please read this Windows XP Professional tutorial, or this Windows Vista/7 tutorial.

When a fax is received via your PC's fax modem that's connected to your dedicated fax phone line, it (the resulting .TIF file) is automatically forwarded by email to the one or more pre-designated email addresses you selected (e.g. myemail@smallbusiness.com, mysecretary@smallbusiness.com, etc). Click here to read the instructions on how you can prepare your Windows Fax to automatically save a copy of each fax that you receive on your hard disk: ForwardFax2Email will do the rest.

-

Faxes are delivered to your e-mail (e.g. in Microsoft Outlook or your web-based email account) where you can save them, print them and forward them, like any other e-mail, or any other file on your computer.

By using the ForwardFax2Email you will:

- Be getting your faxes even when you are not at the office, 24hrs a day.
- Save time in searching through file cabinets and folders looking for an old fax.

- The Successful Software's ForwardFax2Email solution will deliver your faxes to you in standard TIF format which means that you can read/print/save/forward them without the need of buying any other software to make it work.
- No more hard-to-read documents.

- No more loose papers laying around the office fax machine.
- No more calling to the office, hoping someone is there who can tell you if you've received the fax you're looking for, and then re-fax it to you.

- With ForwardFax2Email your faxes in your email your faxes will truly be kept confidential.

Question: Why aren't there any screenshots of the program?

Answer: This product is executed on the background, while you work on your machine, without showing any windows/notifications, etc. However, (if you want) you can select a computerized voice to inform you about the successful forwards of a fax to an email address (or email addresses).

Question: How much system resource this software product requires to run? Will affect my system's performance?

Answer: The ForwardFax2Email is not staying resident on the memory and therefore doesn't affect your system's performance. You schedule it(via the Windows Task Scheduler) to check every 10, 30, 60, 180, etc seconds for any incoming faxes. When the time comes, the ForwardFax2Email is executed, checking for incoming faxes and, if there is one, it forwards it to the designated email account(s). After than it terminates itself automatically freeing the small amount of resources it needs when is executed.

Question: Is this product compatible with Windows 7?

Answer: This product works with all versions of Windows 7 as it is described on this URL:
